


Suggested Packing Requirements for Lavender Oil.

The purpose is to ensure that Lavender oil when shipped within NZ or overseas cannot break or leak, thereby causing possible damage to other parcels and the corresponding possible legal claims. The packed goods must also be able to withstand a minimum 1.2 meter drop without damage.

The following is a suggested method. The NZLGA takes no responsibility for this information or its interpretation or use.

There are three basic parts for the containment.

1. Plastic bag to contain the absorbent material and bottle
2. Chemical absorbent material
3. Lavender Oil container



A. Assembled containment.

The example Chemical absorbance shown here (2) is [a 3M Folded Sorbents product](#).

Other absorbent material could be used.



Once the containment package is complete it can be wrapped in bubble wrap or other packaging suitable for shipping.

If shipping larger quantities, e.g. 1ltr then aluminium containers should be considered for item 3. In addition the items should be packed into a thick walled cardboard box with suitable packaging.

Multiple containers should not be packed together within the same containment pack.
